Kindle is moving into print books now. Both CreateSpace and Kindle are divisions of Amazon, so it remains to be seen how this changes their services. As you investigate options, make sure you are looking at current data. Go directly to the [kdp](#) (Kindle Direct Publishing) and [CreateSpace](#) websites.

20150227UPDATE:

[BookBaby](#) now offers print/POD services, including a hardcover option. If you want a hardcover yearbook, investigate this option as well as [Lulu](#). As I write this, for a conventionally sized hardcover yearbook with 150 color pages, each would cost roughly \$20-40. A comparable paperback from [CreateSpace](#) would be about \$12.
